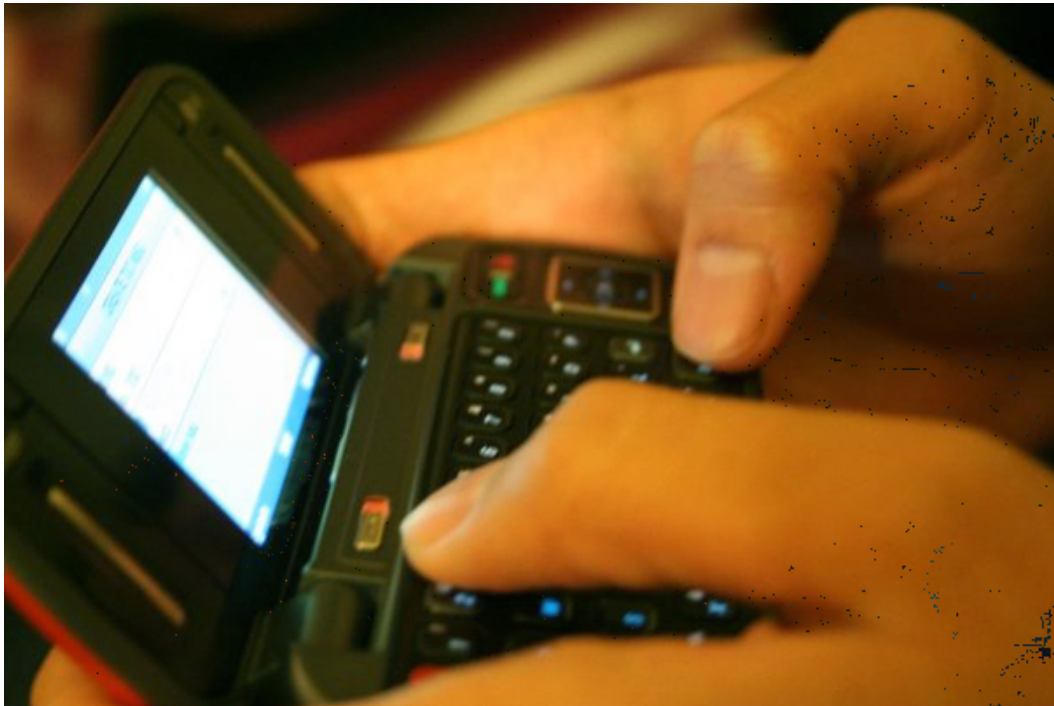


Using Social Media At Conferences
