Example: Program Materials

What language will we use? (e.g., English, Spanish, German)

What level of language will we use? (e.g., 6th grade level, 8th grade level, professional)

What type of language will we use? (e.g., formal, informal/slang, specific dialect)

Are there specific traditions or rituals we should avoid? (e.g., Hazing)


Are there specific traditions or rituals we want to install? (e.g., Hand washing, greeting)

Does the mission and objectives of the program align with our values?

Do we use stories from the local community?

Are we including local stories to guide programing?





Example: Programing

Are we in compliance with laws and regulations? (e.g., ADA)

Are there any laws or regulations that may be problematic? (e.g., anti-DEI laws)

Are there any laws or regulations that are in direct conflict with program values?

























Example: Programing

What do the symbols we use represent?

Can our symbols disenfranchise our participants? (e.g., Confederate statues)

Example: Program Planning

What are will be included in the program? (e.g., music, painting, poetry)

Who will choose which art will be included (e.g., program staff, program participants)

Does the art reflect the community that you are working in?


















Example: Program Planning

What are the beliefs in the local community?

Does any element of the program counter established community beliefs?

If so how, and how will you address it?

Example: Programing

Will we have a dress code?

If so, why? (e.g., functionality-no open toe shoes, quick identification)

What are the unintended consequences of our dress code? (e.g., can't afford)


































Technology
