

## New Resources Coming Soon!

- ERIKA (Electronic Response to Information, Knowledge, and Action) is an illustration-based virtual evaluation tool for children ages 6-12 years. It will be available in 2017 to assess the core competency areas of social conscience, personal values, caring, decision-making, and critical thinking.
- Prevent childhood obesity! C-NAT (CYFAR - Nutrition Assessment Tool) is a screening tool based on the 5210 health campaign that will allow you to gather nutrition-related information and outcomes for children. It is being piloted now and is expected to be available in late fall of 2016.

## New Reporting Tools!

- The cyfar.org website now hosts a new import feature! To make reporting from paper and pencil data collection easier, grantees can import survey result data from a CSV file (i.e., Excel, OpenOffice, or other spreadsheet processing applications).

**Reporting Tips!** *Insert 99 for missing data. - Scale-up 0-3 responses to 1-4 responses. - Avoid using the find and replace feature. - Use this naming convention: first and last two letters of name and birth date.*
