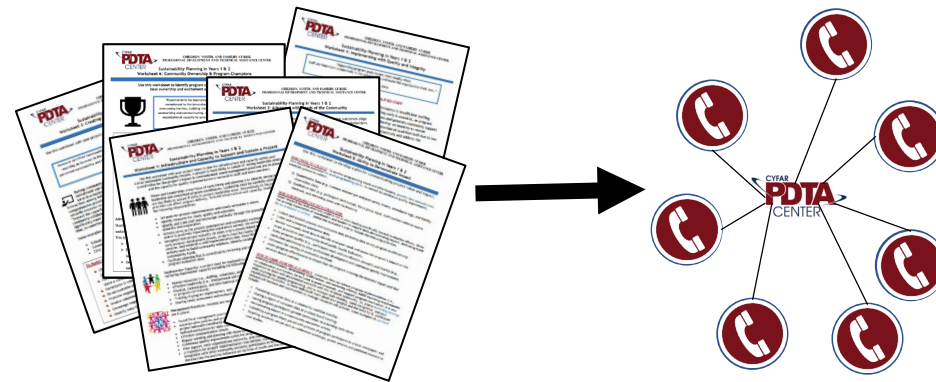

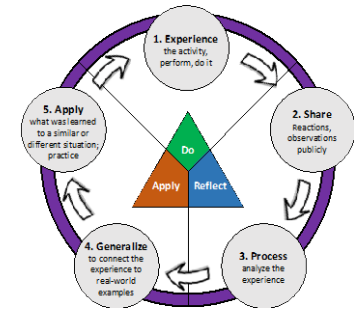

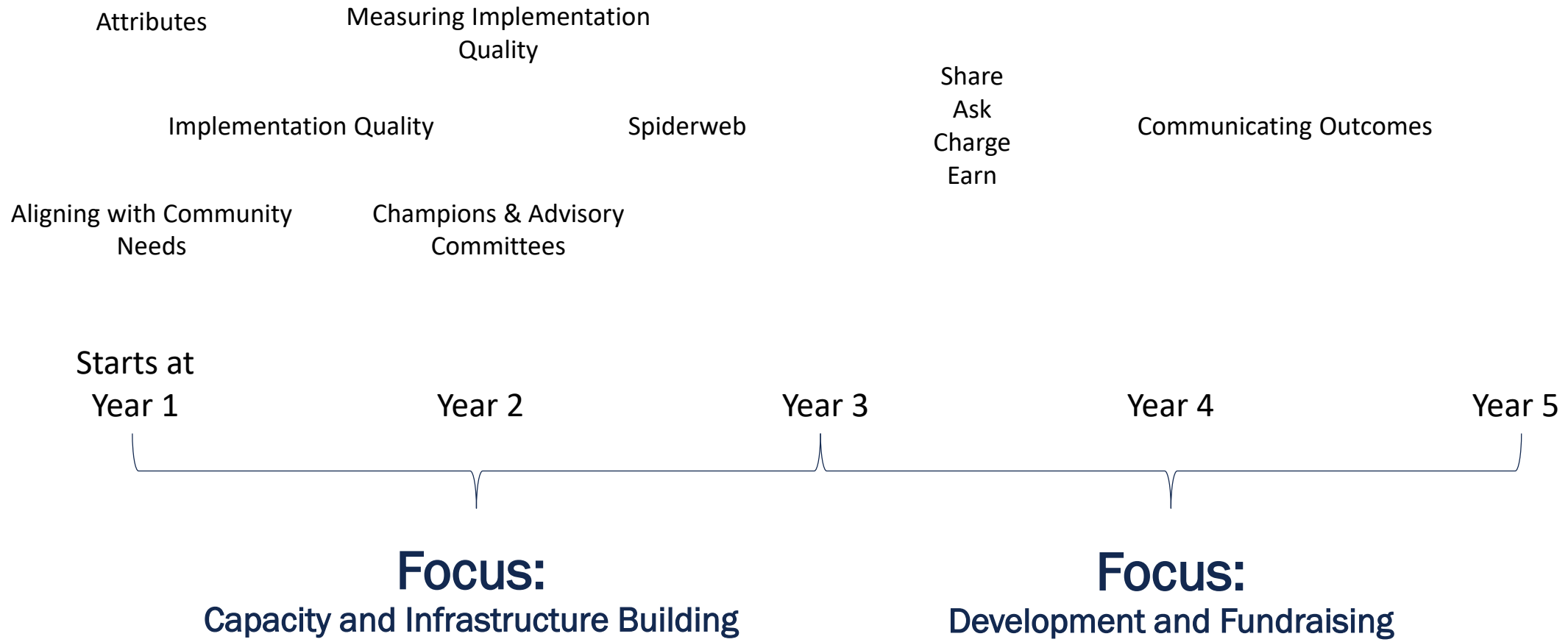

Sustainability Study

Goals of the Study

- USDA-NIFA has asked us to:
 - Identify current sustainability practices of CYFAR SCPs ←
 - Identify the relationship between sustainability practices and ability to continue programming after initial grant funding ends

Program Sustainability Assessment Tool

- **PSAT**
 - Developed at Washington University – St Louis
 - Funded by National Association of Chronic Disease Directors and Centers for Disease Control, Office of Smoking and Health
 - Originally developed for public health programs, but successfully used by public health, social services, clinical care, and educational programs.
- **40 question self-assessment**
 - Program staff and stakeholders will be invited to complete the assessment to evaluate the sustainability capacity of your program.

Program Sustainability Assessment Tool

- 8 domains include:
 - Strategic planning
 - Partnerships
 - Organizational capacity
 - Program evaluation
 - Program adaptation
 - Communications
 - Environmental support
 - Funding stability
- Reliability average of 0.88, with the domains ranging from 0.79 to 0.92
